

## 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Mediterranean Pines Solsona, Spain, September 22-26, 2014



### SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT & CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

#### Welcome

The cycle of MEDPINE conferences was born in 1999 (Mt Carmel, Israel) with the aim of bringing together researchers of all disciplines studying Mediterranean pines\*. Since then it has successfully travelled to Chania (Greece), Bari (Italy) and Avignon (France).

The 5th edition of the MEDPINE conference will be held in the beautiful city of Solsona, in the heart of the Catalan Pre-Pyrenees (northeastern Spain). The conference will be co-organized by the Forest Sciences Centre of Catalonia (CTFC) and the INIA Forest Research Centre in close collaboration with the Centre for Ecological Research and Forestry Applications (CREAF) and the University of Lleida.

Advancing in the understanding of the vulnerability and the adaptive mechanisms of these ecosystems to the different components of global change constitutes the main challenge of this edition!

(\*). Understood like eu-Mediterranean pine species (*Pinus brutia*, *P. halepensis*, *P. heldreichii*, *P. pinaster*, *P. pinea*) or other pines living in the Mediterranean mountains (*P. nigra*, *P. sylvestris*, etc.). Phylogenetically related species (*P. canariensis* and *P. roxburghii*) and pines from other Mediterranean Climate Zones (MCZs) are also relevant.

#### Sessions

The conference is structured in seven **thematic sessions**:

- Evolution and adaptation
- Biodiversity and conservation
- Fire sciences
- Abiotic interactions and climate change
- Biotic interactions
- Stand dynamics and forest management
- Policy and social implications

In addition, the program will include two **debate sessions** around some topical issues that will be selected by the registered participants. These sessions of about 1h pretend to be an open forum to discuss about some controversial/hot topics involving Mediterranean pines. Menu of topics include:

- The role of Med pines in ecological restoration
- The use of Med pine forests for non-wood forest production
- The management of Med pine forests for bioenergy purposes
- The present and future of endangered Med pines

We invite submission of abstract for contributed oral and poster presentations. Each person is allowed to submit only one abstract as first author. The first author is the contact person and will receive all abstract notifications from MEDPINE 5.

The deadline for abstract submission is March 31, 2014.

We have reached a first agreement with the international journals *Annals of Forest Sciences* and *Forest Systems* for publication of selected papers of the conference.
